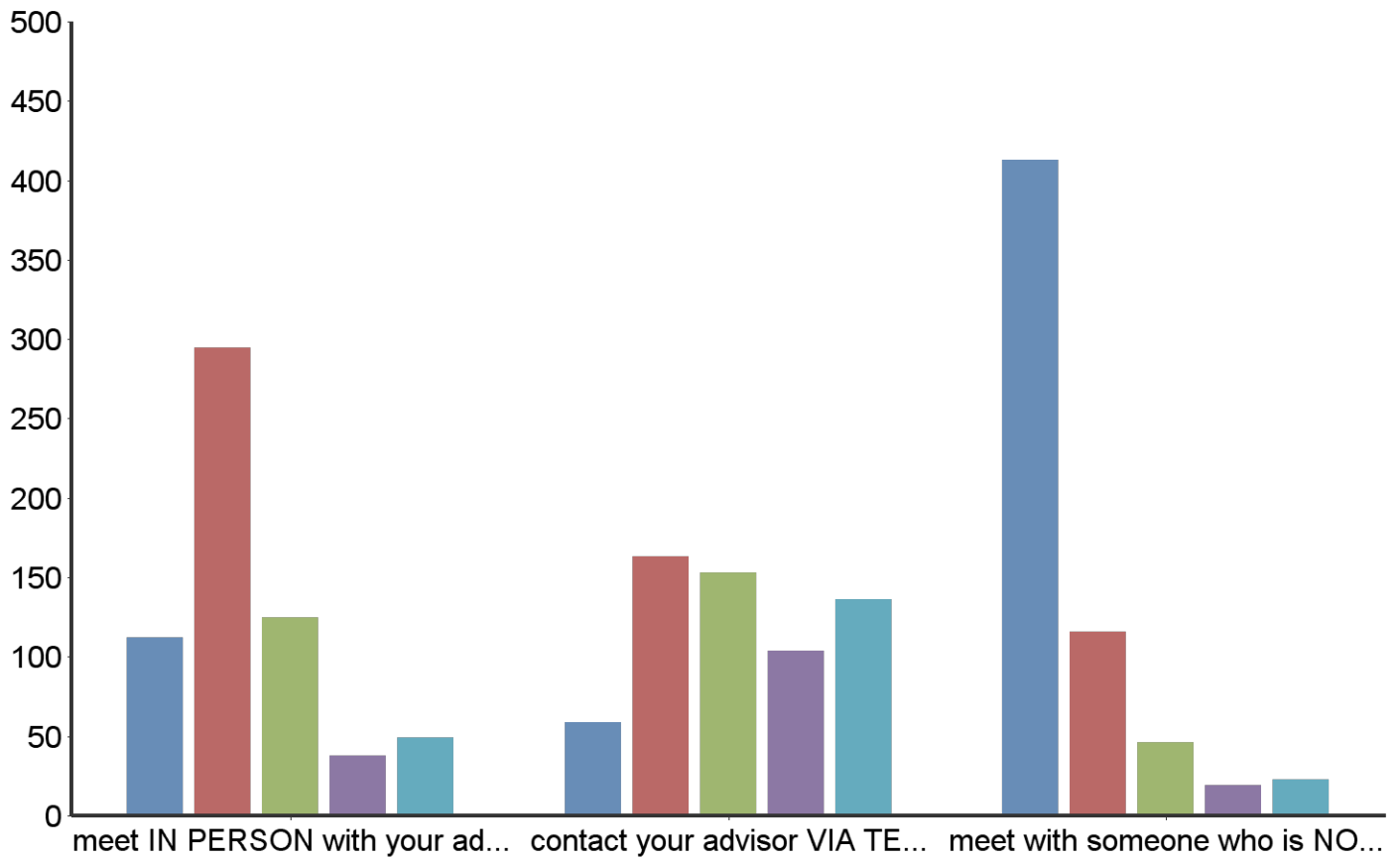

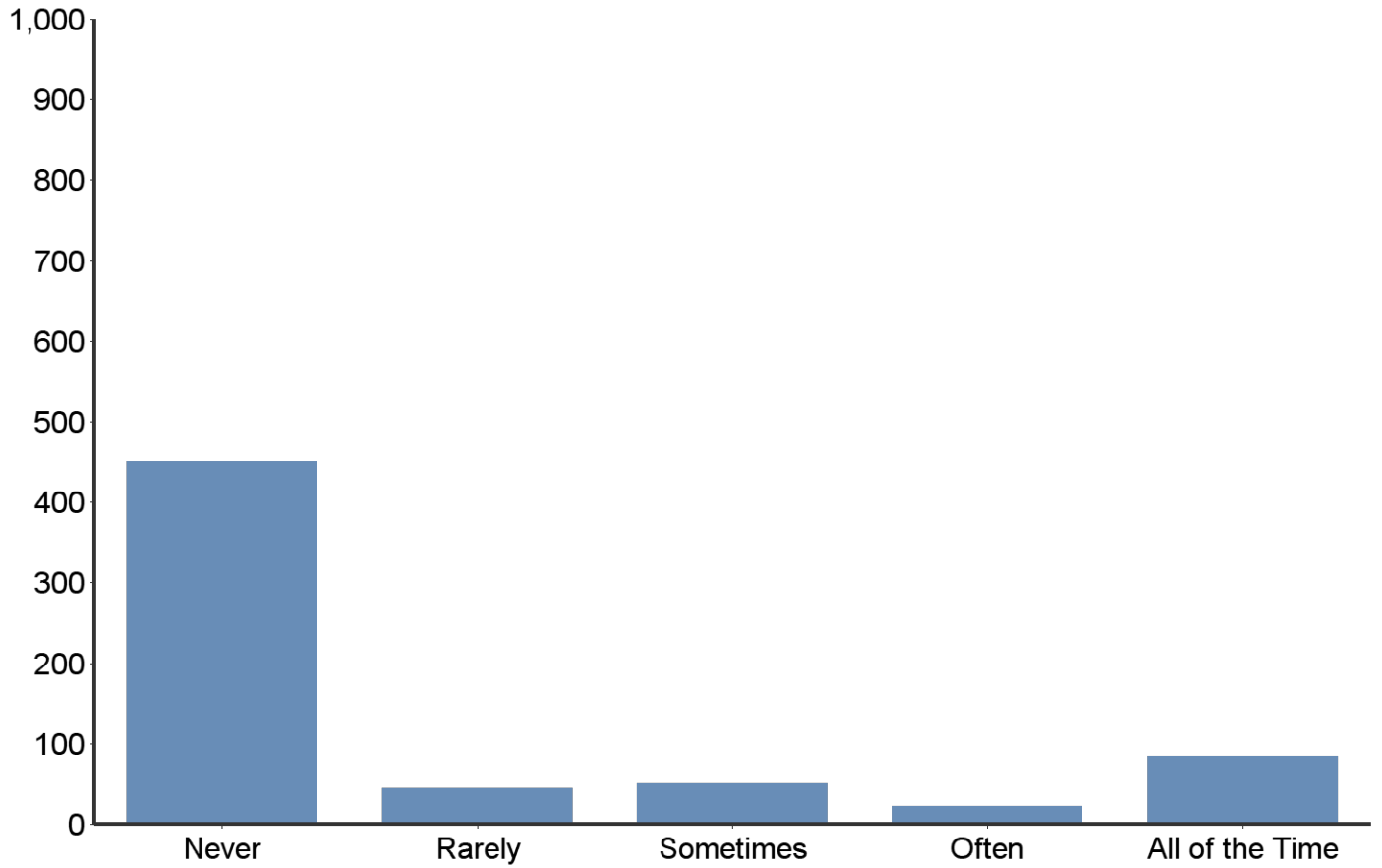

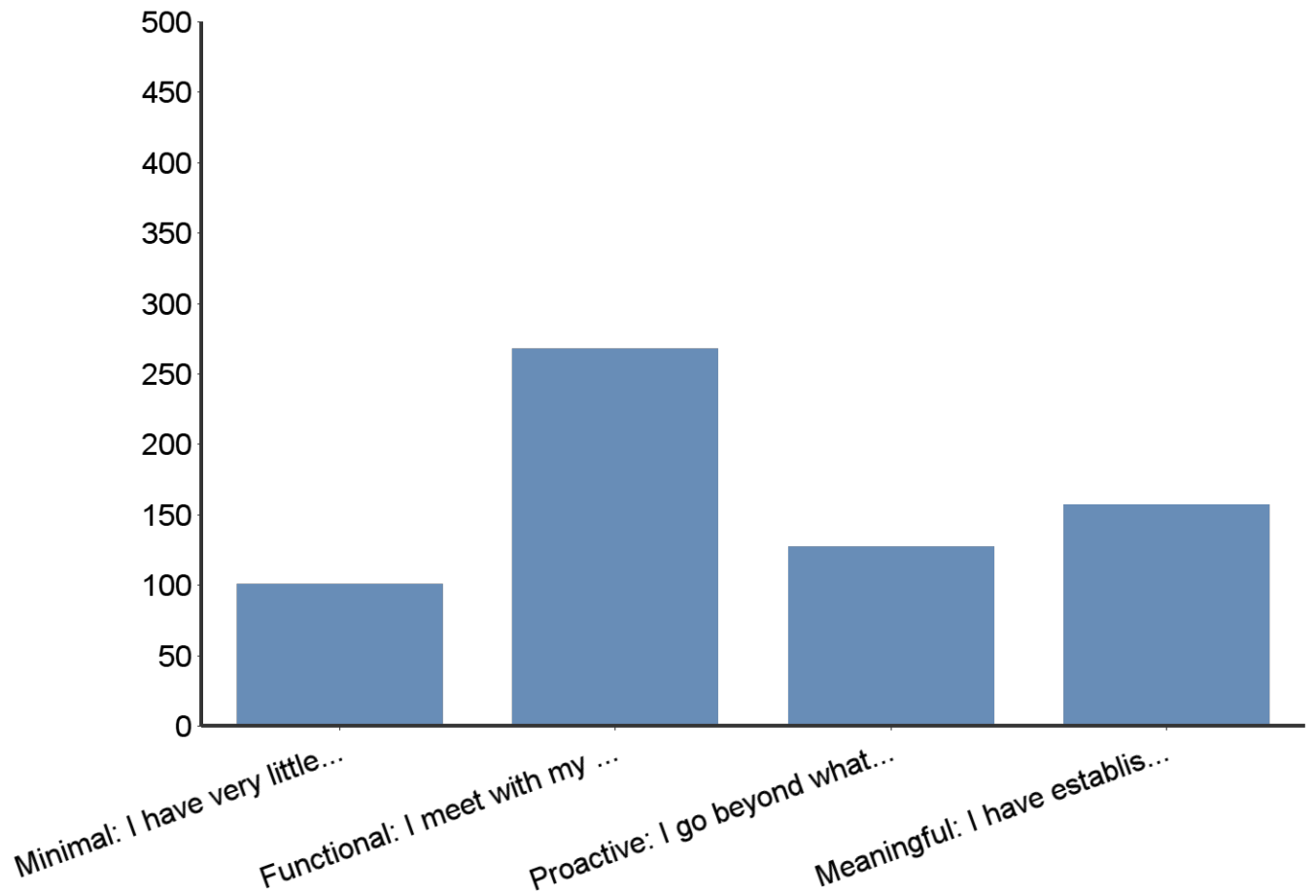

Does your advisor give you your RAC number without meeting with you?



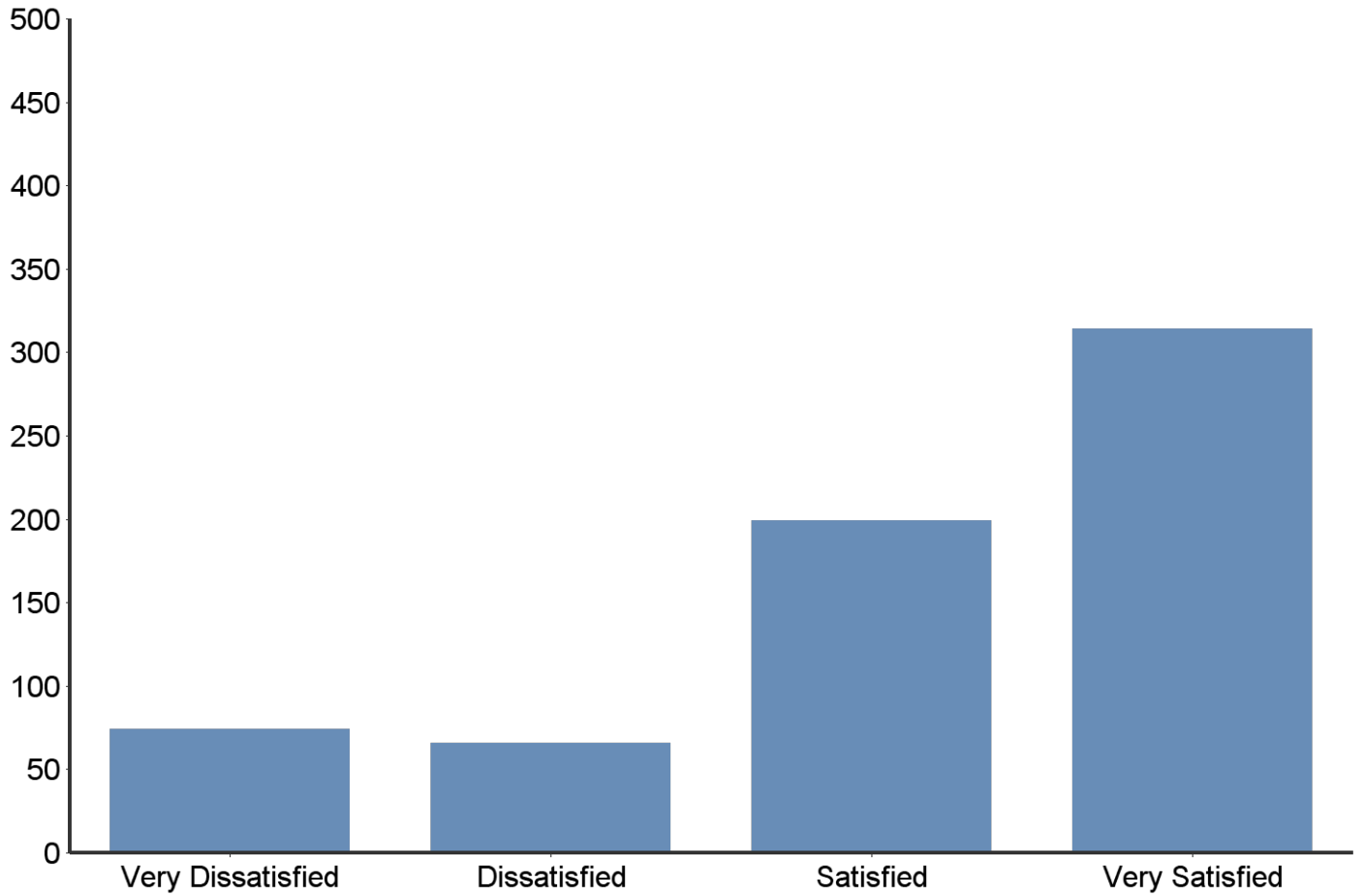

I have gone to many advisors and each tell me I have to change my major to achieve what job I want in the future. There has been constant confusion with my entire academic year at EKU and it is very stressful when the staff tosses you around from person to person. I understand one person cannot know everything about every field but I feel like advisors should advise not send a student off to another building in hopes they find the right person to help them.

I have had 3 different advisers in my 4 years at EKU. The advising office is pointless the staff is uneducated and generally unhelpful. If I had not gone out side the advising office for assistance I would not of been able to graduate on time due to there incontinence.

I declared a major at the end of last year. EKU never directed me to an advisor in my department, and the man that replaced my old advisor didn't help me at all. He simply gave me an RAC and told me to get a new advisor.

Dr. Ware is an asset to the department. She is very proactive in figuring out what you want to do with your degree and getting the networking process started. She really makes sure the students are thinking ahead and making sure we have "all our ducks in a row".

She can be hard to get ahold of to schedule appointment but other than that she is very helpful.

Lakin is a wonderful advisor, she has always answered my questions promptly and thoroughly. Being in a strictly online program limits my face to face interactions with EKU students and staff, but I feel as though I could schedule a meeting with Lakin at anytime.

I do not even know who my advisor is. I also do not know who my admissions counselor is.

Dr. Jensen is the worst advisor and professor I've ever had. She is always unprepared and is never helpful. I was going to have to stay an extra year because of her unless I changed my major. 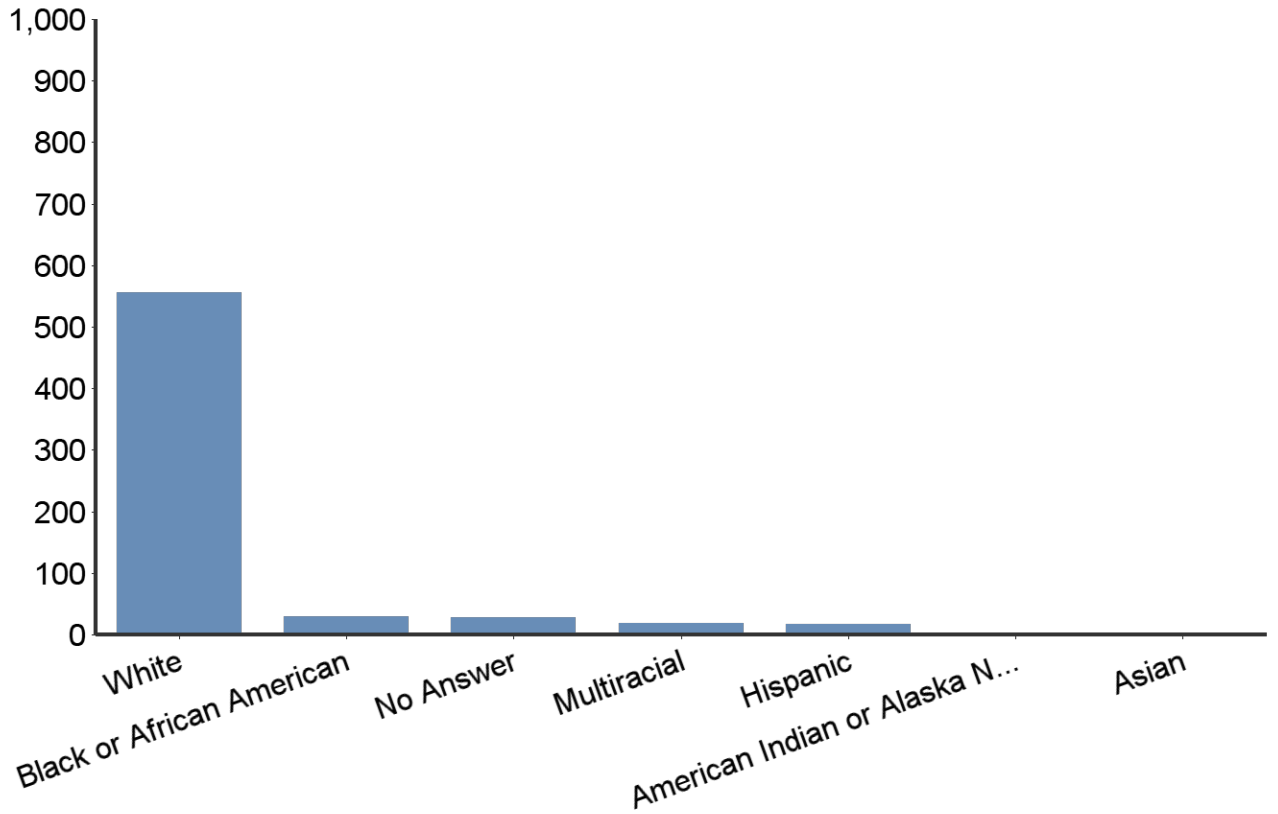
I am also VERY disappointed with the COE Advising team here at EKU. They or my advisor have hardly helped me with the changing of the education courses here on campus.

He's great!

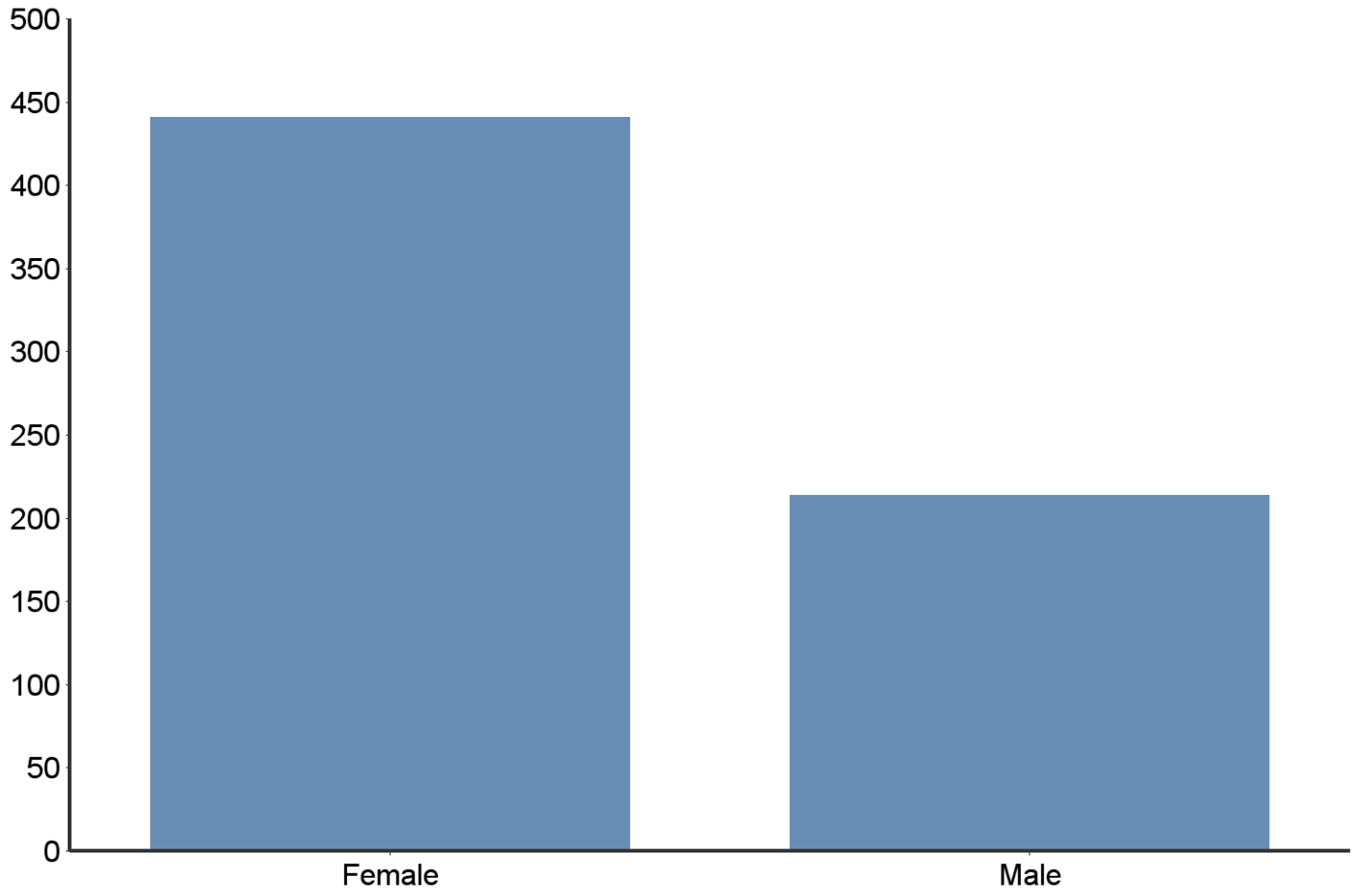
The advisor could explain the degree works better. It took me over an hour playing with it to find out how to get my degree audit.

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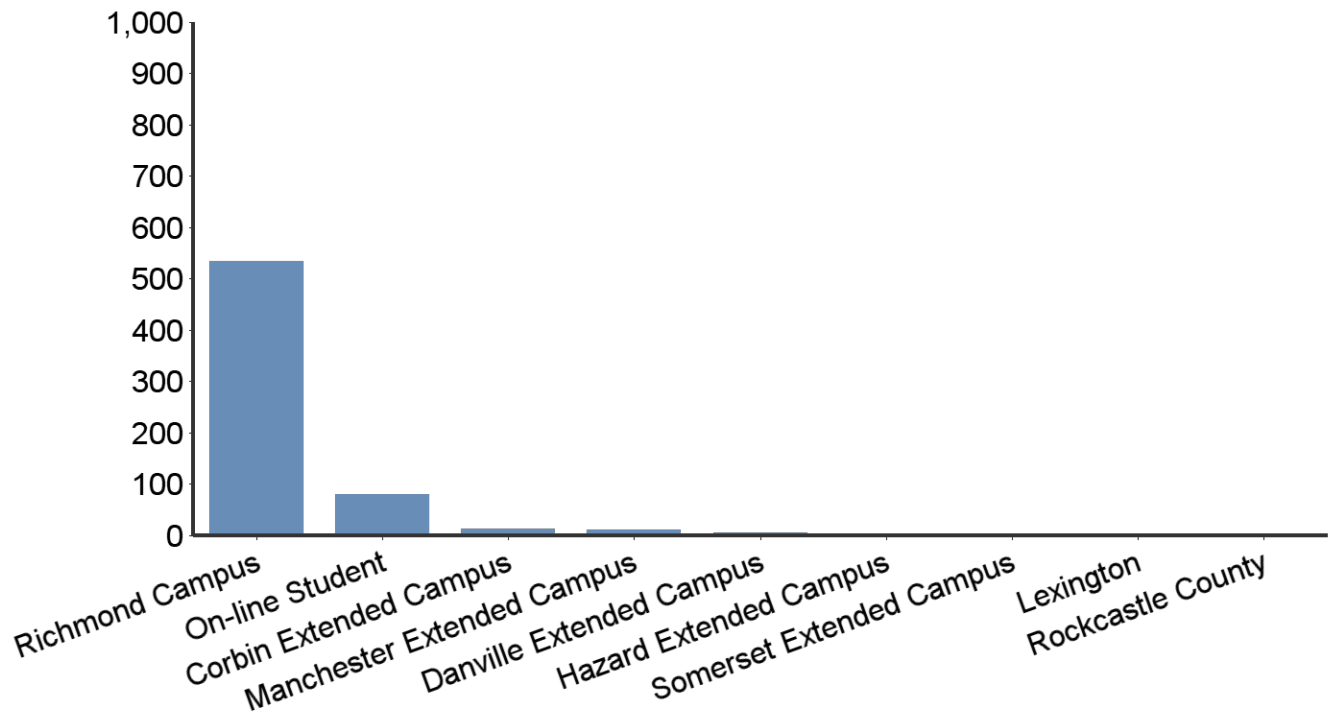
